ACTIVITY 1:- Spinning Sun Activity

Kids blow through a straw to make the paper sun spin, building breath control and fine motor skills.

This shows cause and effect as children learn their action makes the sun move.

Always supervise with straws and pins, and use a paper fastener for safe spinning.

ACTIVITY 2 :-Colorful Spider Activity

Kids thread pipe cleaners into holes around the spider's body to build fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination.

This craft teaches color recognition and counting as children match colors and count 8 legs.

Pre-punch the holes for safety. Let kids choose colors and bend the legs to encourage creativity.

ACTIVITY 3 :- Recognize Phonic Sound Activity

Kids match picture cards to their beginning letter sound to build phonemic awareness and letter-sound connection.

This game develops early reading skills as children say the word, hear the first sound, and find the correct letter.

Use real objects or cards for hands-on learning. Start with 3-4 sounds, then add more as kids gain confidence.

ACTIVITY 4:- Number & Quantity Matching Activity

Kids count bottle caps and match them to the correct number card to build one-to-one correspondence and number recognition.

Using tongs to pick pom poms and place them in caps adds fine motor control and strengthens pincer grip.

Start with numbers 1-5 for beginners. Use different colors to also reinforce color sorting while counting.

ACTIVITY 5:- Hand & Color Matching Game

Kids match their hand to the same color circle to build color recognition and left-right discrimination.

This fast-paced activity improves visual motor coordination and reaction speed as they move to the correct color.

Play with one hand, then two. Add music or a timer for fun. Great for focus and listening skills.
