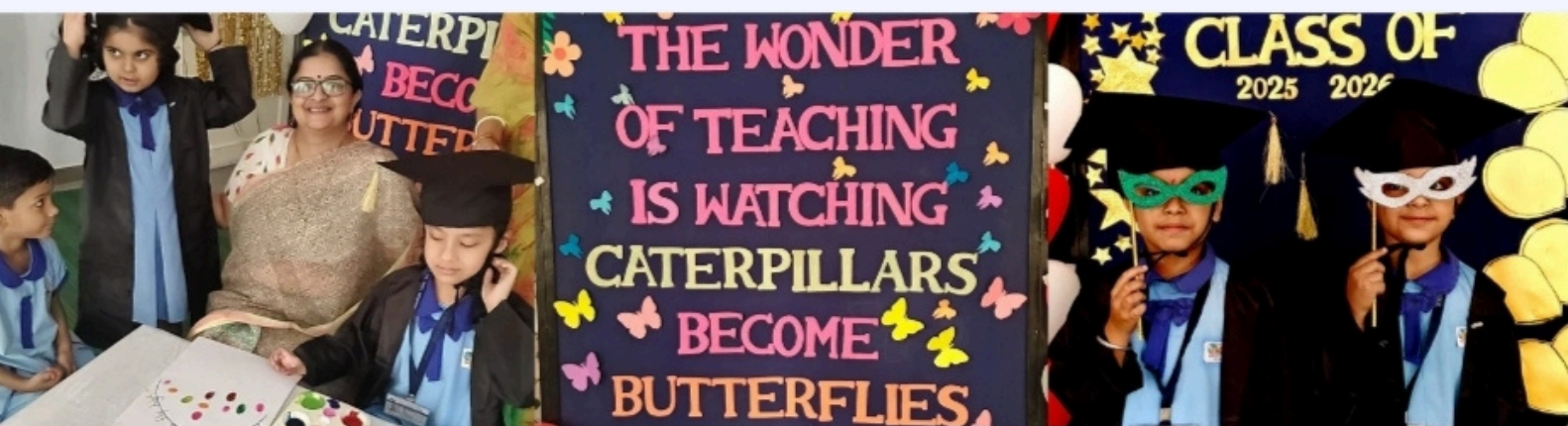
The celebration concluded on a high note, leaving everyone filled with pride, joy, and a deep sense of patriotism.

A tribute to the guardians of the nation

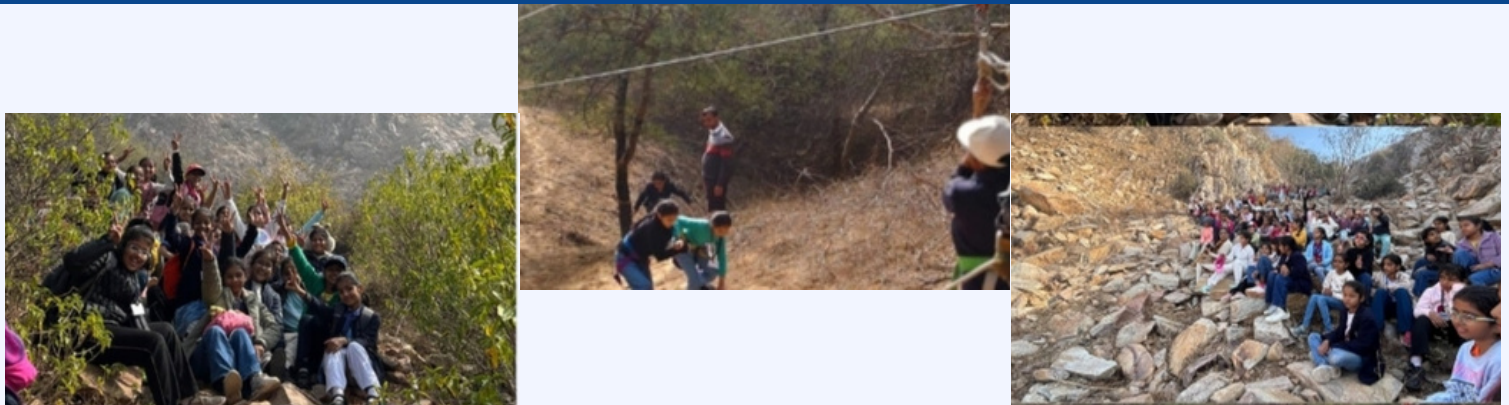


A nation sleeps peacefully only when brave soldiers stand alert at its borders.

Empowering Students to Stay Safe Online



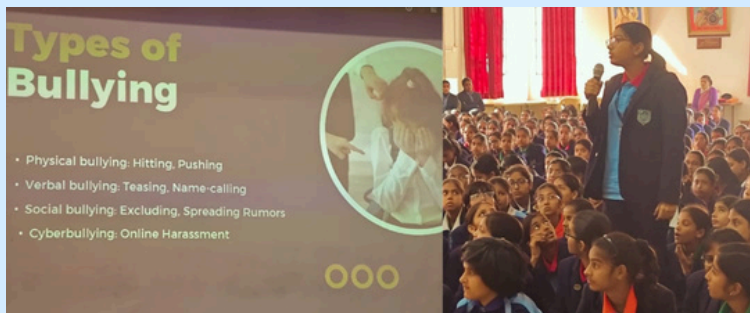

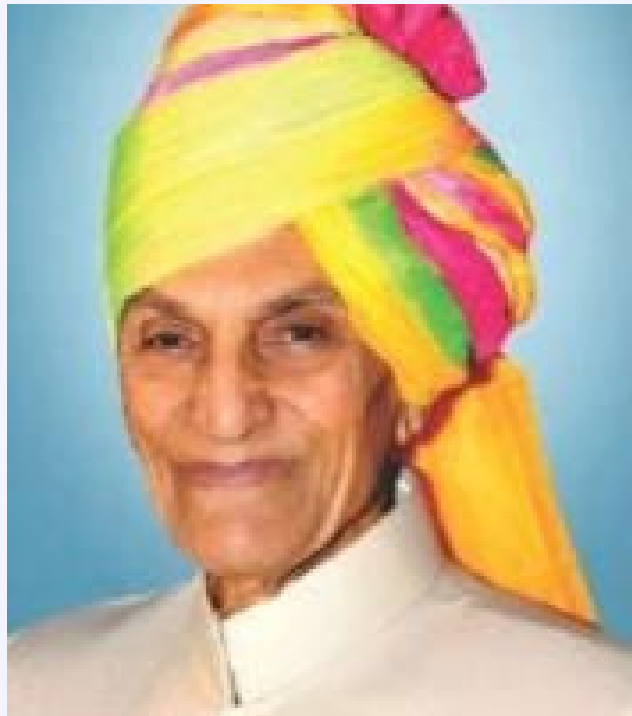
